Funding for a safer digital future

Australia's commitment to the sector is backed by funding of more than A\$11.7 billion over the next decade.

This will enable the best in the business to develop and deploy advanced cyber security solutions that will protect our critical infrastructure and create a safer digital world.

We have a suite of incentives, grants and support to help businesses and talented individuals bring their cyber security skills and ideas to our shores, including a A\$100 million digital skills package offered through our Digital Economy Strategy 2030.

Tax incentives are available for R&D into cyber security, while industry and education providers may be eligible for up to A\$3 million under the Cyber Security Skills Partnership Innovation Fund to help grow a skilled cyber security workforce.

The new A\$9.9 billion investment announced in 2022, REDSPICE, will expand the range and sophistication of our intelligence, offensive and defensive cyber capabilities, and create A\$5 billion in opportunities for Australian industry.

Five of our major cities have Joint Cyber Security Centres – innovation hubs that provide a forum for industry, academia, government and the research community to share information and ideas.

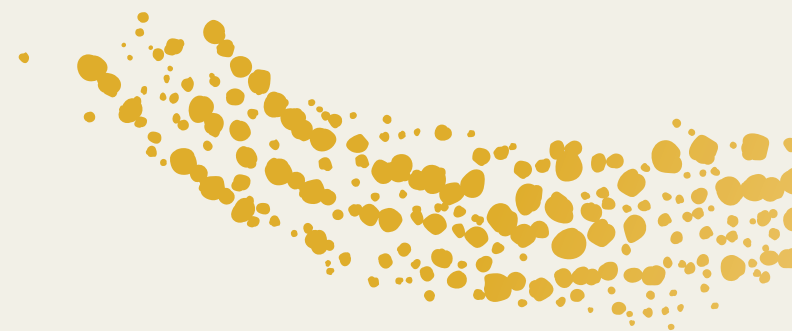

- 26,500 people were employed in cyber security in Australia
