Giving business a boost

Receive up to 45% of eligible digital games development spending back through government rebates.

Eligible businesses spending at least \$500,000 on games development can get 30% of this investment back through an Australian Government tax rebate, called the [Digital Games Tax Offset](#).

NSW, Victoria, Queensland and South Australia also offer state rebates ranging from 10% to 15% of eligible games development spending.

Grants of up to \$150,000 are also up for grabs through Screen Australia for independent Australian studios with a game development budget of up to \$500,000. [The Games: Expansion Pack](#) grants will be available until 30 June 2023.

Australian-based businesses can also access the Australian Government's [research and development tax incentive](#) for ground breaking technological projects.
